A fast-paced, gritty space opera based on cutting edge science.

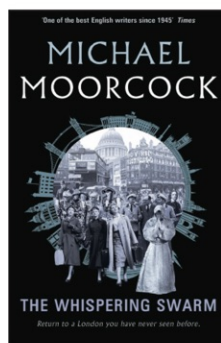
