This exceptional new thriller from Joe Hill is essential reading for 2016 and perfect for fans of Justin Cronin’s *The Passage*.

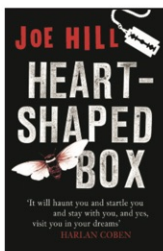
