

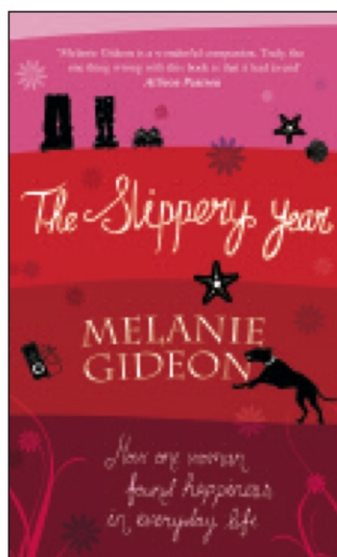
John Browne Beyond Business

John Browne joined BP in 1966 and became Chief Executive nearly thirty years later. Tracing his role in growing BP to one of the world's largest energy companies, from spectacular oil-well blow-outs in Iran in his teenage years to his resignation in 2007, Browne is able to offer unrivalled insight into the big topics of today, including leadership, climate change, globalisation and corporate social responsibility.
