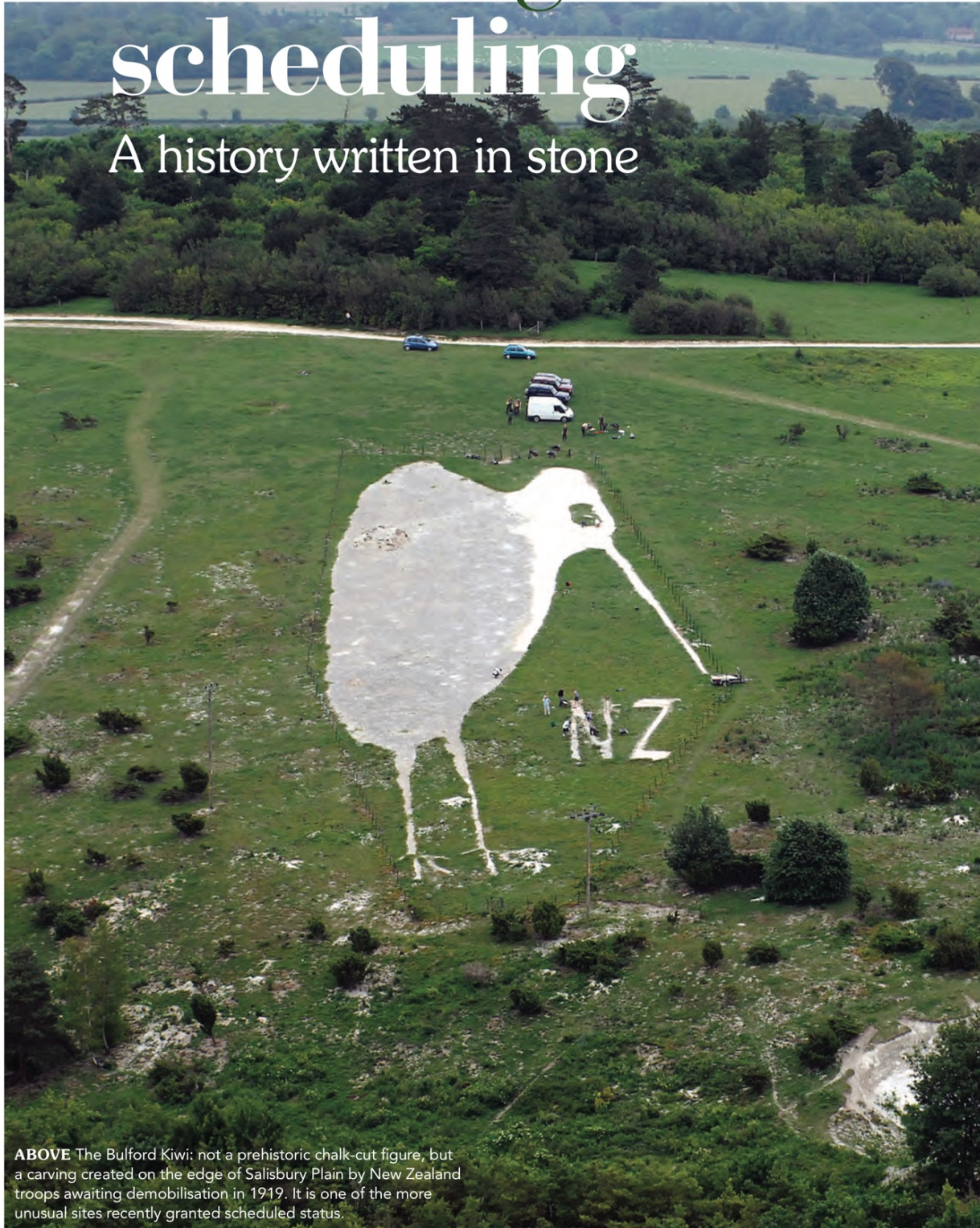


Celebrating scheduling
